Dear Students and Parents/Carers

This year's GCSE results day is on Thursday 20th August. Due to the government guidelines regarding Covid-19 we have had to adapt the process for how students are issued their results. Students can either book an appointment to come into school and collect their results, or request for them to be posted home.

If you would like to collect your results on the 20th August you can either telephone the school on 01843 831999 (you will not be able to contact the school by telephone after Friday 17th July) or follow the link that has been emailed to your school email account. Please do this by Wednesday 22nd July to book a time for you to attend. In line with exam board rules, only students can collect their results. These 'appointments' will be fifteen minutes long and only students will be able to come into the school building to avoid too many people gathering inside. We are extremely disappointed that students will not be able to open and share their results in the main hall with friends, family and staff as in previous years, but we know you understand why the school has to take these precautions.

As per previous years you have the right of appeal. We currently do not have the final details from the government of how this will work this year but staff will be available on results day to discuss this with you if necessary
